18159 Dependent Resurvey, Portion of the Subdivisional Lines,  
T. 31 S., R. 4 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon

CHAINS

A fir, 5 ins. diam., bears N. 12 3/4° E., 31  
lks. dist., mkd. X BT.

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 15 3/4° E., 27  
lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S30 BT.

Deposit white "DEEP-1" magnetic marker at  
base of stainless steel post.

S 89° 10' W., beginning new measurement.

Descend over SW. Slope.

37.80 Packard Creek, 5 lks. wide, course N. 5° W.; asc. over  
broken NE. slope.

38.92 Intersect the E. bdy. of T. 31 S., R 5 W.

Point for the closing cor. of secs. 19 and 30, at  
proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence  
of the original corner.

Set a stainless steel post., 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam.,  
24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

lks. dist., mkd. T31S R4W S19 CC BT.

A madrone, 4 ins. diam., bears S. 48° E., 12  
lks. dist., mkd. X BT.

Deposit white "DEEP-1" magnetic marker at base of  
stainless steel post.

From this point, the cor. of secs. 24 and 25, T. 31 S.,  
R. 5 W., bears S. 0° 18' E., 5.88 chs. dist., herein-  
before described.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky clay.

Timber, fir, maple, madrone, hemlock, cedar, yew, pine,  
alder, oak, and dogwood; undergrowth, poison oak, salal,  
Oregon grape, arrowwood, manzanita, rhododendron, black-  
berry, ferns, huckleberry, vine maple, and young timber.

The point for the 1/4 sec. cor. of sec. 30 only, T. 31 S.,  
R. 4 W., is at midpoint latitudinally on the W. bdy. of  
sec. 30.

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam.,  
24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
