GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land covered by this survey and resurvey is located in Douglas County, approximately 7 miles southwest of Riddle, Oregon. Access is by way of Glenbrook Loop County Road, No. 39, to Council Creek County Road No. 93 and numerous other gravel and dirt roads. The area is drained northeasterly by Council Creek, southwesterly by Gravel Creek, northwesterly by Island Creek, and with numerous other small and seasonal drainages.

The area is mountainous with elevations ranging from about 1,760 feet above sea level at the corner of section 7, 8, 17, and 18, to 3,120 feet above sea level near the center 1/4 section corner of section 18.

The soil is rocky clay. There were no mineral deposits noted along the lines surveyed. The timber consists of fir, hemlock, cedar, madrone, maple, pine and chinquapin. The undergrowth consists of salal, poison oak, Oregon grape, ocean spray, hazel, huckleberry, blackberry, fern and vine maple.

The land is used mainly for timber production.

The average of a number of readings along the lines surveyed gives a mean magnetic declination of $18\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ E., with a range of $3/4^{\circ}$ in local attraction.
