CHAINS

The following field notes are those of the dependent resurvey of a portion of the south boundary township 21 south, range 9 west, and a portion of the subdivisional lines, and Donation Land Claim lines, and subdivision of section 5, township 22 south, range 9 west, Willamette Meridian, Oregon.

The history of surveys pertaining to this resurvey, is as follows:

Donation Land Claims No. 37 through 45, were surveyed by Dennis Hathor, U. S. Deputy Surveyor, in 1856.

The north boundary was surveyed by Alonzo Gesner, U. S. Deputy Surveyor, in 1894.

A portion of the subdivisional lines was surveyed by Alonzo Gesner and Elmer O. Worrick, U. S. Deputy Surveyors in 1894.

A portion of the subdivisional lines and the Donation Land Claims were resurveyed by George S. Pershin, U. S. Deputy Surveyor, in 1896.

A portion of the north boundary and subdivisional lines was resurveyed by Harvey E. Wofford, Wayne L. Rogers, and Owen C. Chatters II, Cadastral Surveyors, in 1973-79.

A portion of the subdivisional lines was resurveyed and a portion of the subdivisional lines was correctively resurveyed by Steven J. Malloy and John P. Farnsworth, Cadastral surveyors, in 1982-84.

The survey was executed in accordance with the specifications as set forth in the Manual of Surveying Instructions, 1973, and the Special Instructions, dated July 2, 1985, under Group No. 1281, Oregon.

The directions of the lines were determined by deflections from azimuths obtained by direct solar observations, and refer to the true meridian.
