	From this point, a point established by person(s) unknown, bears S. 6° E., 0.031 chs. dist., monumented with an iron pipe, 1½ ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 2 ins. above ground.
	N. 89° 16' W., on the N. bdy. of Claim No. 39.
	Ascend over SE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
0.040	The crossing closing cor. of secs. 4 and 5, hereinbefore described.
1.05	Spur ridge, bears N. 5° W. and S.; desc. over SW. slope.
19.20	Bottom of descent, slopes S.; asc. over SE. slope.
25.70	Spur, slopes S. 25° E.; desc. over SW. slope.
39.12	Point for the crossing closing cor. on the N. and S. center line of sec. 5, hereinafter described.
45.90	Wells Creek, 12 lks. wide, course S. 20° W.; asc. over SE. slope.

	Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

	A fir, 28 ins. diam., bears S. 21 3/4° E., 113 lks. dist., mkd. T22S R9W C39 BT.
	A fir, 21 ins. diam., bears N. 8½ W., 154 lks. dist., mkd. T22S R9W C39 BT.
