A maple, 12 ins. diam., bears S. 55° W., 51 lks. dist., with scribe marks ¼ S35 BT visible on partially healed blaze.

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N. 81° W., 25 lks. dist., with scribe marks ¼ S26 BT visible on partially healed blaze.

N. 89° 10' W., beginning new measurement.

Descend over NW. slope, through moderate timber and undergrowth.

7.40 Gravel road, 20 lks. wide, bears NW. and SE.

11.30 Creek, 4 lks. wide, course N. 40° E.; continue descent over N. slope.

20.455 Point for the W 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 26 and 35.

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 9 ins. diam., bears N. 12° E., 30½ lks. dist., mkd. W 1/16 S26 BT.

An incense cedar, 10 ins. diam., bears S. 20½° W., 17 lks. dist., mkd. W 1/16 S35 BT.

Deposit white "DEEP-1" magnetic marker at base of stainless steel post.

Descend over SW. slope.

22.05 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course S. 20° W.; ascend over SE. slope.

29.30 Gravel road, 25 lks. wide, bears N. 65° E. and S. 65° W.

34.90 Gravel road, 25 lks. wide, bears N. 50° W. and S. 70° E.

40.91 The cor. of secs. 26, 27, 34, and 35.

Land, mountainous.  
Soil, rocky clay.  
Timber, fir, pine, cedar, madrone, hemlock, chinquapin, maple, and alder; undergrowth, salal, poison oak, Oregon grape, ocean spray, hazel, huckleberry, blackberry, and ferns.
