	<p><b>GENERAL DESCRIPTION</b></p> <p>The area covered by this survey is located in Douglas County, approximately 9½ miles southeast of Glide, Oregon. Access is by way of Little River County Road No. 17, to Cavitt Creek County Road No. 82, and numerous other gravel and dirt roads. The area is drained northwesterly by Everts Creek and Buckshot Creek and easterly by McKay Creek, Boulder Creek and Copperhead Creek, all into Cavitt Creek which drains northerly with numerous other small and seasonal drainages. The area is mountainous with elevations ranging from about 1000 feet above sea level at the ¼ section corner of sections 14 and 23, to about 2800 feet above sea level near the ¼ section corner of sections 35 and 36.</p> <p>The soil consists of a rocky clay. There were no mineral deposits noted along the lines surveyed. The timber consists of fir, hemlock, cedar, oak, madrone, maple, pine, and chinquapin. The undergrowth consists of salal, poison oak, Oregon grape, ocean spray, hazel, huckleberry, blackberry, fern and vine maple.</p> <p>The land is used mainly for timber production. Section 23 is subdivided with several residential homes. It also contains a BLM recreation site along Cavitt Creek.</p> <p>The average of a number of readings along the lines re-surveyed gives a mean magnetic declination of 18 3/4° E., with a range of 1° in local attraction.</p>
