CHAINS

Meanders of Clear Lake

I find the var. to be 20° 12' E. at 8 A M April 13, 1891.

Commence at meander corner on North side of Lake on Coast Meridian West boundary of Section 19 which is a post 4 inches square 2 feet above ground marked M C on South T 22 S on North R 12 W S 19 on East R 13 W S 24 on West faces.

from which

A chittam 10 ins diam bears S 85° W 50 lks dist marked T 22 S R 12 W S 24 M C BT

An alder (old BT) bears N. 80° E 40 lks dist marked T 22 S R 12 W S 19 M C BT
