CHAINS

The area is mountainous, with elevations ranging from about 480 feet above sea level near the $\frac{1}{4}$ section corner of sections 22 and 23, to 1200 feet above sea level on the west boundary of section 22. No evidence of mineral deposits was noted in the area.

The average of a number of observations gives a value of $18\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ East for the mean magnetic declination. There is a range of up to $3/4^{\circ}$ due to local attraction.
