- 38.100 The cor. of secs. 28, 29, 32 and 33, monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 6 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd.

A root hole, bears N. 53½° E., 10 lks. dist., with a down cedar alongside, 14 ins. diam., no marks visible.

A hemlock snag, 22 ins. diam., bears S. 70° W., 37 lks. dist., with fragmentary scribe marks visible on partially healed blaze.

A sawed cedar stump, 48 ins. diam. bears N. 38° W., 15 lks. dist., no marks visible on partially healed blaze.

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S. 54° E., 38 lks. dist. with healed blaze. (Record, S. 58½° E.)

and the remains of bearing trees mkd. by Vernon R. Tracy, Deputy County Surveyor, in 1966

A sawed cedar stump, 21 ins. diam., bears N. 79° E., 42 lks. dist., with scribe marks 25 S 28 CS visible on partially healed double blaze.

A yew, 7 ins. diam., bears S. 3° E., 20 lks. dist., with fragmentary scribe marks visible on partially healed double blaze.

A fir, 7 ins. diam., bears N. 11° E., 6 lks. dist., mkd. T25S R3W S28 BT.

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 85½° W., 63 lks. dist., mkd. X BT.

A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears N. 30° W., 13 lks. dist., mkd. T25S R3W S29 BT.

The corner is located on SW. slope, at the top of a road cut bank.

From the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 9 and 16, monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set, projecting 12 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd.
