GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The area covered by this survey is located in Douglas County, approximately four to nine miles northeast of Glide, Oregon. Access is by way of County Road No. 19 to BLM Road NO. 25-4-2.0 and Hinkle Creek County Road No. 281, also by way of State Highway 138 to BLM Road 26-3-17.1, and numerous other gravel and dirt roads.

The area is drained southerly by French Creek and northwesterly by Hinkle Creek, with numerous other small and seasonal drainages. The area is mountainous with elevations ranging from about 1,000 feet above sea level at the ¹/₄ section corner of sections 4 and 5, to about 2,400 feet above sea level near the corner of sections 28, 29, 32, and 33.
