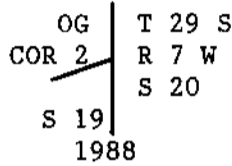

Survey for the Location of the Oro Grande Placer Claim in
Section 19, T. 29 S., R. 7 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon

CHAINS

- 3.380 Gravel road, 20 lks. wide, bears N. 40° E. and S. 40° W.
- 4.545 Point for Cor. No. 2 of the Oro Grande placer claim, at record distance.

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.



from which

A pine, 4 ins. diam., bears S. 73° E., 46½ lks. dist., mkd. X BT.

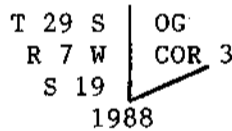
A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N. 77° W., 34 lks. dist., mkd. OG 2 BT.

S. 60° 02' 00" W., on line 2-3 of Oro Grande placer claim.

Descend over gradual NE. slope, through medium timber and moderate undergrowth.

- 2.20 Gravel road, 20 lks. wide, bears N. 40° E. and S. 40° W.
- 21.905 Intersect the E. and W. center line of the SE¼ of sec. 19.
- 22.725 Point for Cor. No. 3 of the Oro Grande placer claim, determined at a point 1500 ft. southwesterly of Cor. No. 2, and 300 ft. southerly of Coarse Gold Creek.

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.



from which

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N. 55° E., 59 lks. dist., mkd. OG 3 BT.

A hemlock, 24 ins. diam., bears S. 21° W., 30½ lks. dist., mkd. X BT.

Deposit a white "DEEP-1" magnetic marker at the base of the stainless steel post.

N. 0° 42' 30" E., on line 3-4 of Oro Grande placer claim.

Descend over gradual NE. slope, through medium timber and moderate undergrowth.

- 0.530 Intersect the E. and W. center line of the SE¼ of sec. 19.
- 4.545 Point for Cor. No. 4 (west center end corner) of the Oro Grande placer claim, located at the center of Coarse Gold Creek, 10 lks. wide, course N. 60° E. No permanent monument established.

N. 0° 42' 30" E., on line 4-5 of Oro Grande placer claim.
