The mean magnetic declination is 20° E.

Beginning at the cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19, and 24, on the W. bdy, of the Tp., monumented with a galvanized iron post, 1½ ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 15 ins. above ground, in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, to top, with bronze cap mkd.

30 lks. dist.

The center of a madrone clump, bears S. 15° E.,
56½ lks. dist.

A mutilated ponderosa pine snag, 28 ins. diam.,
bears S. 70° W., 91½ lks. dist., no marks remain.

A live oak clump, bears N. 45° W., 31 lks. dist.

A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N. 74½° E., 131½ lks. dist.,
with fragmentary scribe marks visible on partially
healed blaze.

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S. 24° E., 73 lks. dist.,
with fragmentary scribe marks visible on partially
healed blaze. This tree was mkd. by Popken and
Carlson in 1976.

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 63° W., 17 lks. dist.,
with healed blaze. (Popken and Carlson, 1976)

A fir, 38 ins. diam., bears N. 1° W., 92½ lks. dist.,
with fragmentary scribe marks visible on partially
healed blaze.
