A, a cut 16 ft. wide, 18 ft. face, runs S. 15° E., 20 ft. to face. Value, \$750.	
No. 2	A dam, the center of which bears N. 81° 23' E., 721 ft. from Cor. No. 4, Morning Star Placer; 200 ft. long, 6 ft. high, 12 ft. wide at crest, 3:1 side slopes, curves to NE and S. Value \$ 500.
