CHAINS

Access is gained via a gravelled road along Lane Creek and dirt roads extending south from Boomer Hill.

No mineral deposits were noted along the lines surveyed, although the Hanna Nickle mining claims are immediately west of the area. The land is used mainly for timber and grazing of livestock.

The average of a number of readings taken in the area gives a value of $18^{\circ} 00'$ E. for the mean magnetic declination. There is a range of $0^{\circ} 30'$ due to local attraction.
