Intersect a local corner established to mark the intersection with the south boundary of the William P. Day Donation Land Claim (Claim No. 37 in T. 29 S., R. 9 W., and Claim No. 44 in T. 29 S., R. 8 W.) by Ben B. Irving, Deputy County Surveyor, in 1930, monumented with an iron rod, 1 in. diam., firmly set, with top 2 ins. below the surface of the ground, as recorded in Douglas County Surveyors Office Map File No. 4/59. This corner is accepted in this survey.

From this point, the SW. cor. of Donation Land Claim No.37, bears S. 89° 14' 00" W., 9.800 chs. dist., monumented with an iron post, 1½ ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 12 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N. 56° E., 77 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

A grand fir, 21 ins. dia., bears S. 55° W., 7 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

N. 0° 09' 00" W., beginning new measurement.
