CHAINS

Descend over SE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

3.540 Intersect the line bet. secs. 25 and 30, point for the crossing closing corner.

The corner point is occupied by a fir, 40 ins. diam. Mark the tree T29S R7W S30 on the NE. face, T29S R8W S25 on NW. face, and TR 55 on S. face.

A fir, 13 ins. diam., bears N. 84° E., 62 lks. dist.,
mkd. T29S R7W S30 CCC BT.

A stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., set
22 ins. in the ground, for a reference monument, bears
N. 45° W., 10 lks. dist., with brass cap mkd. RM T29S R8W
S25 CCC 6.6 FT 1989, and an arrow pointing to the corner.

From this point, Cor. No. 1 of Tract 55, bears S. 75° 07' 30" E.,
21.010 chs. dist., monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam.,
firmly set, projecting 7 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd.

A madrone 38 ins. diam., bears S. 74° W., 53 lks. dist.,
with partially healed decayed blaze, no scribe marks
remain.

and a new bearing tree

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 36½° W., 95 lks. dist.
mkd. AP1 TR55 BT.

From this same point, the ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 25 on the E. bdy. of
T. 29 S., R. 8 W., bears S. 0° 10' 30" W., 13.995 chs. dist.,
hereinbefore described.

From Cor. No. 2 of Tract 55.

S. 1° 21' 00" W., on line 2-3 of Tract 55.

Descend over SE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

1.30 Ravine, drains S. 75° E.; asc. over broken NE. slope.

16.25 Spur, slopes E.; desc. over SE. slope.

18.620 Corner No. 3 of Tract 55, monumented with an iron post, 1 in.
diam., firmly set, projecting 6 ins. above ground, with brass cap
mkd.
