CHAINS

from which the remains of bearing trees mkd. by Tillman, Holm and Brooks

A root hole, bears S. 38° W., 124 lks. dist., lying alongside is a fir stump, 45 ins. diam., face area buried.

A hemlock stump, 40 ins. diam., bears N. 55° W., 64 lks. dist., with scribe marks T19S R10W S19 visible on partially healed blaze. (Record, fir, 70 lks.)

and new bearing trees

An alder, 16 ins. diam., bears S. 64° W., 58 lks. dist., mkd. T19S R10W S24 BT on the bark.

A fir, 5 ins. diam., bears N. 4° W., 161 lks. dist., mkd. X BT.

N. 3° 57' 00" E., on the E. bdy. of sec. 13.

Ascend SE. slope, through logged area, posting true line.

2.20 Rock road, 25 lks. wide, bears N. 80° E., and S. 80° W.

4.60 Spur, slopes S. 70° E.; desc. broken NE. slope.

9.00 Spur, slopes S. 20° E.; desc. E. slope.

10.955 The closing cor. of secs. 18 and 19, T. 19 S., R. 9 W., monumneted with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 2 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd.

A root hole, bears N. 82° E., 63 lks. dist.

A fir stump, 44 ins. diam., bears S. 6° E., 62 lks. dist., no marks visible.

and the remains of a bearing tree reported by Beck and Peterson

A fir stump, 47 ins. diam., bears N. 7½° E., 60 lks. dist., with healed blaze. (Record, N. 14° E.)

and the remains of a bearing tree mkd. by Beck and Peterson

A cedar stump 18 ins. diam., 8 ft. high, bears S. 28° E., 141 lks. dist., with scribe marks T19S R10W S19 CC BT visible on partially healed blaze.

and new accessories

A fir, 4 ins. diam., bears N. 59¼° E., 58½ lks. dist., mkd. X BT.

A stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., set 28 ins. in the ground, for a reference monument, bears S. 2° 36' W., 75.5 lks. dist., with brass cap mkd. RM T19S R9W S19 CC 49.8 FT TO COR 1989 and an arrow pointing to the corner.

Corner is located on a spur, slopes E.
