A root hole, bears N. 70° E., 9½ lks. dist.

A fir stump, 50 ins. diam., 1 ft. high, bears S. 60° E.
43 lks. dist., no marks visible.

and new accessories

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N. 37° E., 41½ lks. dist.,
mkd. ¼ S18 BT.

A stainless steel post, 28 ins. long 2½ ins. diam., set 28
ins. in the ground, for a reference monument, bears N. 83°
16' E., 79.5 lks. dist., with brass cap mkd. RM ¼ S18 52.5
FT TO COR 1989 and an arrow pointing to the corner.

N. 4° 27' 30" E., beginning new measurement.

Ascend SE. slope, through logged area.

3.80 Overgrown rock road, 25 lks. wide, bears N. 80° E. and S. 80° W.,
enter timber.

4.70 Spur, slopes S. 30° E.; asc. E. slope.

9.00 Slope changes to asc. steep SE. slope.

11.90 Top of steep ascent; asc. SE. slope.

16.10 Spur, slopes N. 70° E.; desc. broken N. slope.

33.10 U.S. Forest Service Road No. 4890-918, gravel, 20 lks. wide, bears
N. 70° W. and E., in a curve; desc. NE. slope.

36.950 The cor. of secs. 12 and 13 only, described in the field notes of
the corrective dependent resurvey of a portion of the E. bdy. of T.
19 S., R. 10 W., executed concurrently under this same group.

From the cor. of secs. 24 and 25 only, on the E. bdy. of the Tp.

N. 88° 47' 00" W., bet. secs. 24 and 25.

Descend SW. slope, through timber.

1.15 Ravine, drains N. 60° W.; asc. broken NE. slope.

12.00 Left bank North Fork Smith River, bears N. 70° W., and S. 70° E.,
70 lks. wide, course S. 70° E.

14.10 Right bank North Fork Smith River, bears N. 70° W. and S. 70° E.;
asc. NE. slope.

14.90 Top of riverbank, bears N. 70° W. and S. 70° E.; asc. broken NE.
slope, through logged area.

38.145 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 24 and 25, at proportionate
distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
