A root hole, bears N. 54° E., 15 lks. dist., with a

A double madrone, 19 ins. diam., bears S. 15° E.,
32 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

and bearing trees mkd. by Mensch

A ponderosa pine, 19 ins. diam., bears S. 36° W.,
45 lks. dist., with healed double blaze.

A ponderosa pine, 20 ins. diam., bears N. 20° W.,
81 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

and a bearing tree mkd. by Byron

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N. 65° E., 32 lks. dist.,
with healed double blaze.

N. 0° 04' 30" W., bet. secs. 32 and 33.

Ascend over SW. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

11.20 Spur, slopes SW.; desc. over broken NW. slope.

19.970 Point for the S 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 32 and 33.

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in
the ground, with brass cap mkd:

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N. 81½° E., 69 lks. dist.,
mkd. S 1/16 S33 BT.

A white fir, 17 ins. diam., bears S. 56° W., 65 lks.
dist., mkd. S 1/16 S32 BT.

Deposit white "DEEP-1" magnetic marker at base of stainless steel
post.

From this point, a corner established and recorded by Russell B.
Bass, Registered Land Surveyor No. 558, in 1976, bears N. 71° 17'
00" E., 0.066 chs. dist., monumented with a stainless steel pipe, 1½
ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 12 ins. above ground.

This point was established using improper procedure and is not
utilized in this survey.

Descend over broken N. slope.

25.350 The cor. of secs. 32 and 33 only, on the N. bdy. of the Tp., mon-
umented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 10
ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd.
