Field Notes of Survey of a Placer Mining Claim No. 37 for D.A. Levens on the 5th and 6th day of December A.D. 1877 in Green Mountain District, Douglas County State of Oregon.

Beginning at the junction of Brandy Gulch with Hogam Creek, initial point, Thence N.02½°E. five chains and fifty links to a yew post three feet long and four inches in diameter marked on four sides M.S. also C. 37. Set for N.E. corner of claim on right bank one hundred links East of Hogam Creek from said post, a yew tree 8 inches in diameter bears S.20°E. 11 lks. and yellow fir 50 inches diameter bears N.61°W. 15 lks.
