9, 16, and 17.

- S.89° 51' W., on true line bet. secs. 8 and 17.
- Desc. 65 ft. over rolling NW. slope, through scattering  
timber and dense undergrowth.
- 11.50 Spur, slopes NW.; desc. 275 ft. over NW. slope.
- 20.80 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course N.10°W.; asc. 65 ft. over NE.  
slope.
- 22.60 Spur, slopes N.; desc. 10 ft. over NW. slope.
- 24.40 Branch, 1 lk. wide, course NE.; asc. 415 ft. over NE.
