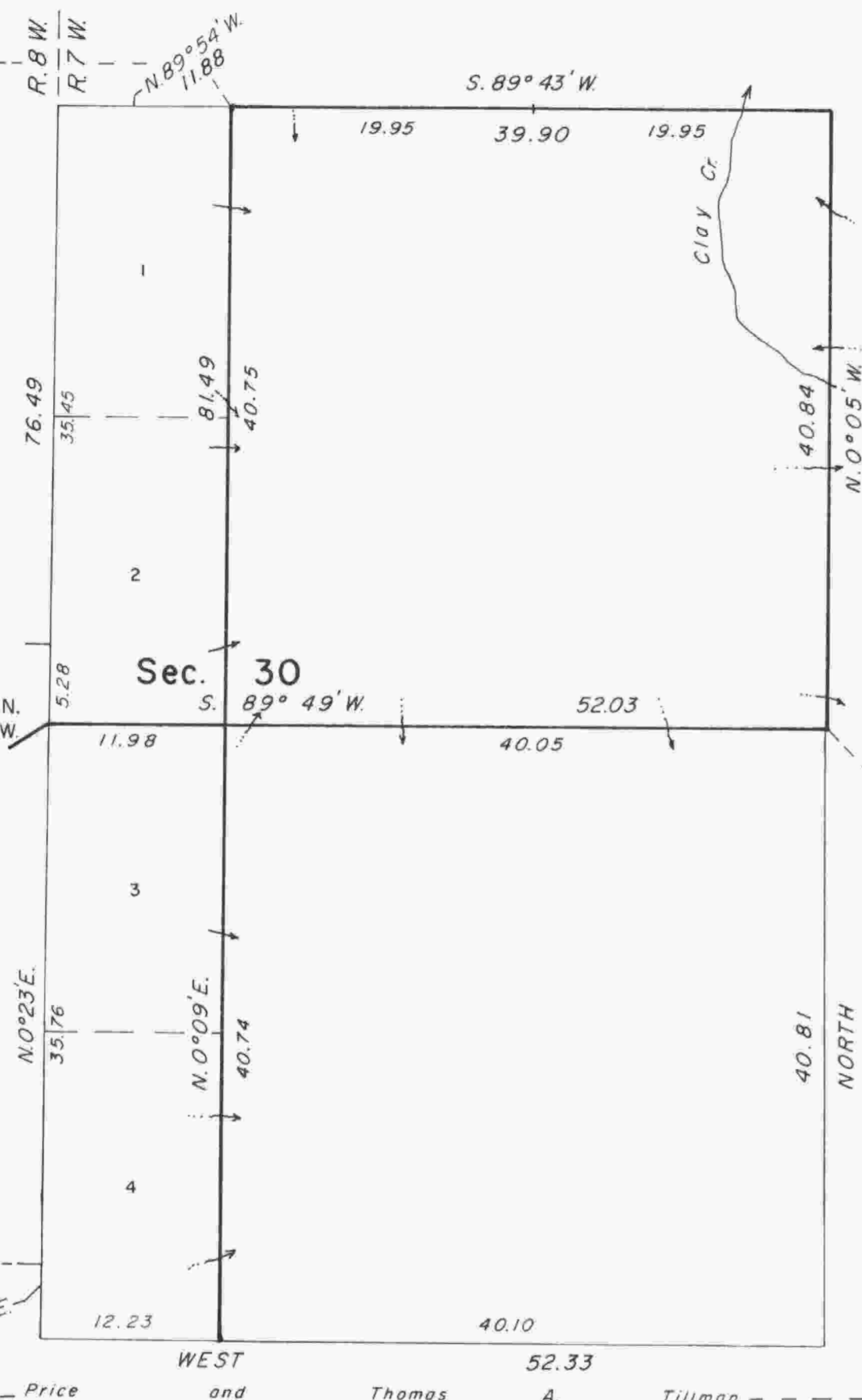

The history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents a dependent resurvey of a portion of the subdivisional lines, T. 19 S., R. 7 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, and the subdivision of section 30.

The lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved April 4, 1892.

The survey was executed by Philip G. Griffin, Cadastral Surveyor, beginning March 31, 1986, and completed April 24, 1986, pursuant to Special Instructions dated February 3, 1986, under Group Number 1309, Oregon.

Timber in this area consists of fir, maple, madrone, chinquapin, hemlock, wild cherry, and alder.
