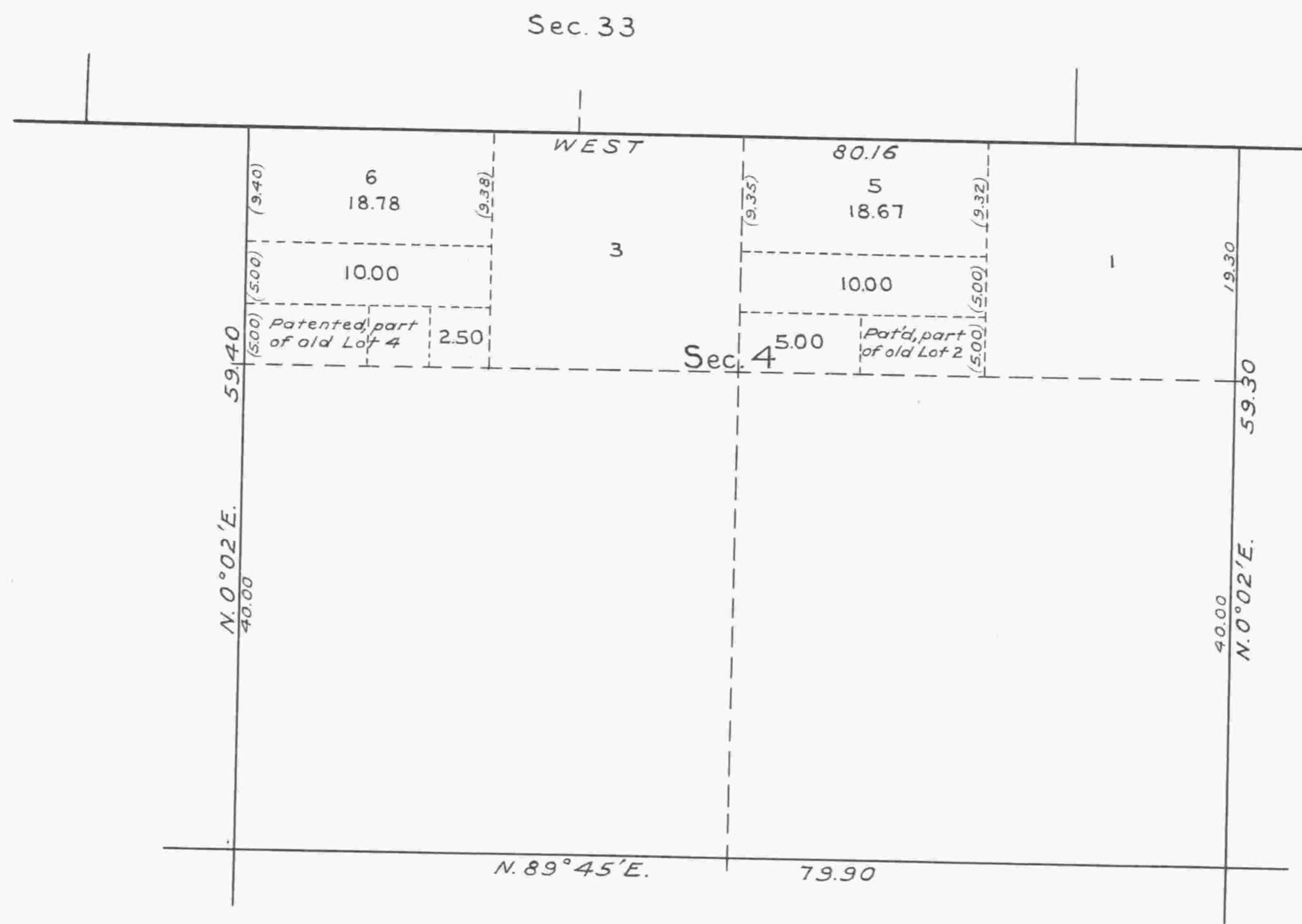


TOWNSHIP N° 19 SOUTH, RANGE N° 9 WEST,

The above supplemental plat of Sec. 4, Township No. 19 South, Range No. 9 West, of the Willamette Meridian, Oregon, based upon the plat approved February 12, 1901 and showing subdivisions of original lots 2 and 4, is made to accommodate an application of H. E. Reed for an exchange of land under the act of March 20, 1922, (42 Stat. 465), which includes, among other lands offered to the Government in this exchange, those described as N $\frac{1}{2}$ lot 2, N $\frac{1}{2}$ S $\frac{1}{2}$ lot 2, S $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{2}$ lot 2, N $\frac{1}{2}$ lot 4, N $\frac{1}{2}$ S $\frac{1}{2}$ lot 4, and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ lot 4 of said Sec. 4; prepared in accordance with the Commissioner's letter "E" dated March 29, 1930 and is hereby approved.
