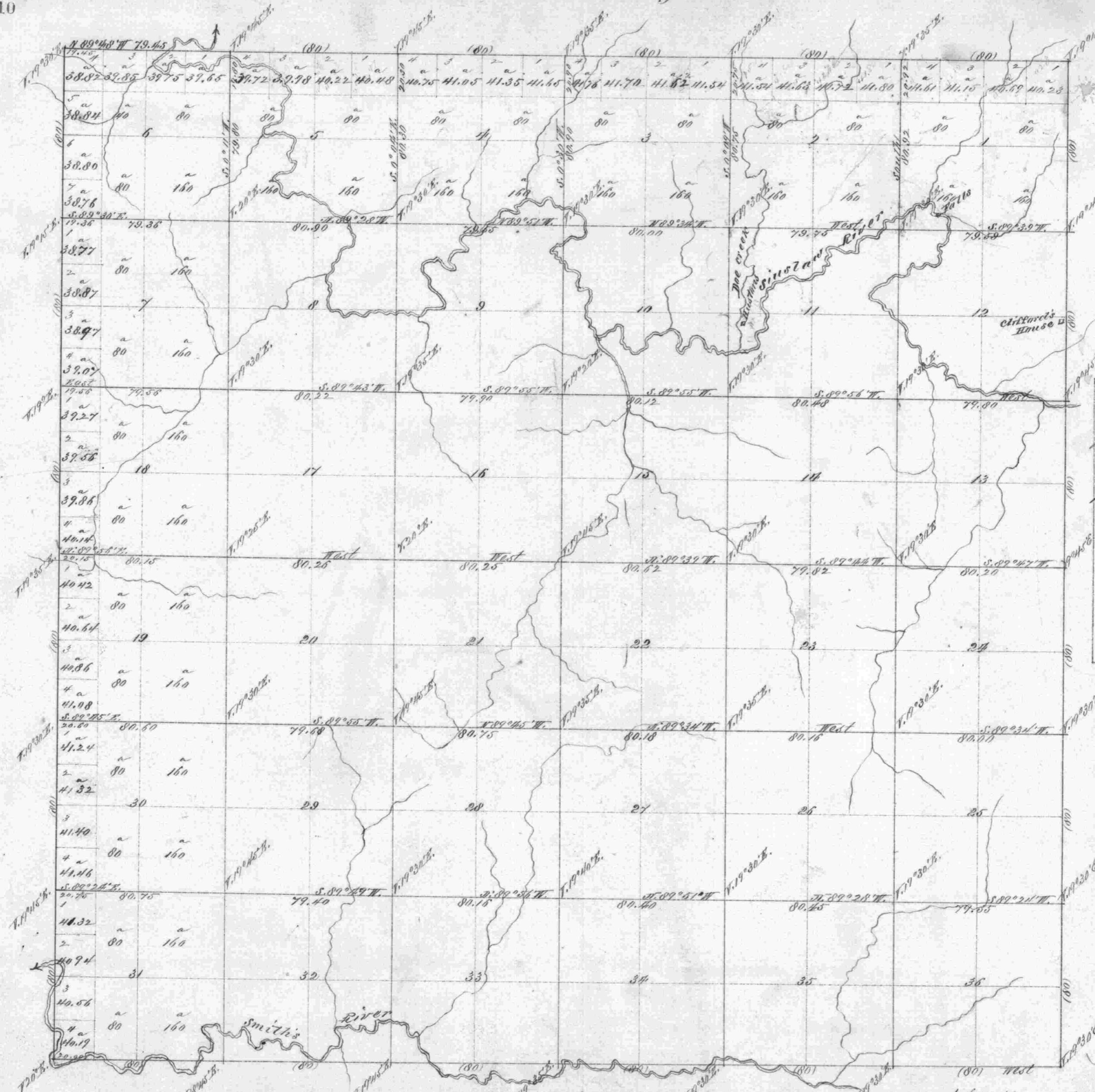

General Description
 The lands in this township are generally rough, rugged and second only to forest of spruce and hemlock timber and a few undergrowth of thin maple, maple for fuel, chinquapin, etc. The soil on the mountains is 2^d and 3^d rate, while that along the streams is either 1st or 2^d rate. The only level land of any consequence lies along streams and Smith's river, and this consists of narrow bottoms heavily timbered and covered with a dense undergrowth.
