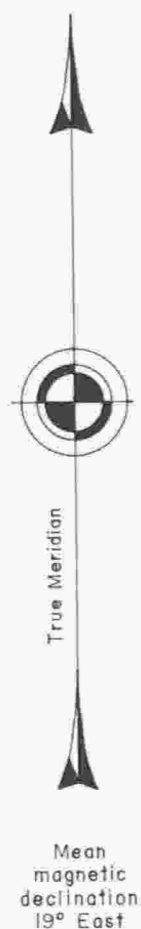

A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents a dependent resurvey of the line between sections 26 and 27, T. 20 S., R. 6 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence.

The lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved January 23, 1873.

The survey was executed by Wayne L. Rogers, Cadastral Surveyor, beginning August 8, 1989, and completed August 22, 1989, pursuant to Special Instructions dated June 5, 1989, under Group Number 1495, Oregon.

Timber in this area consists of fir, cedar, hemlock, yew, alder, maple, madrone, willow and chinquapin.
