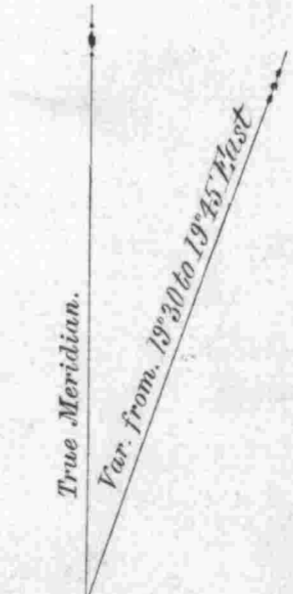
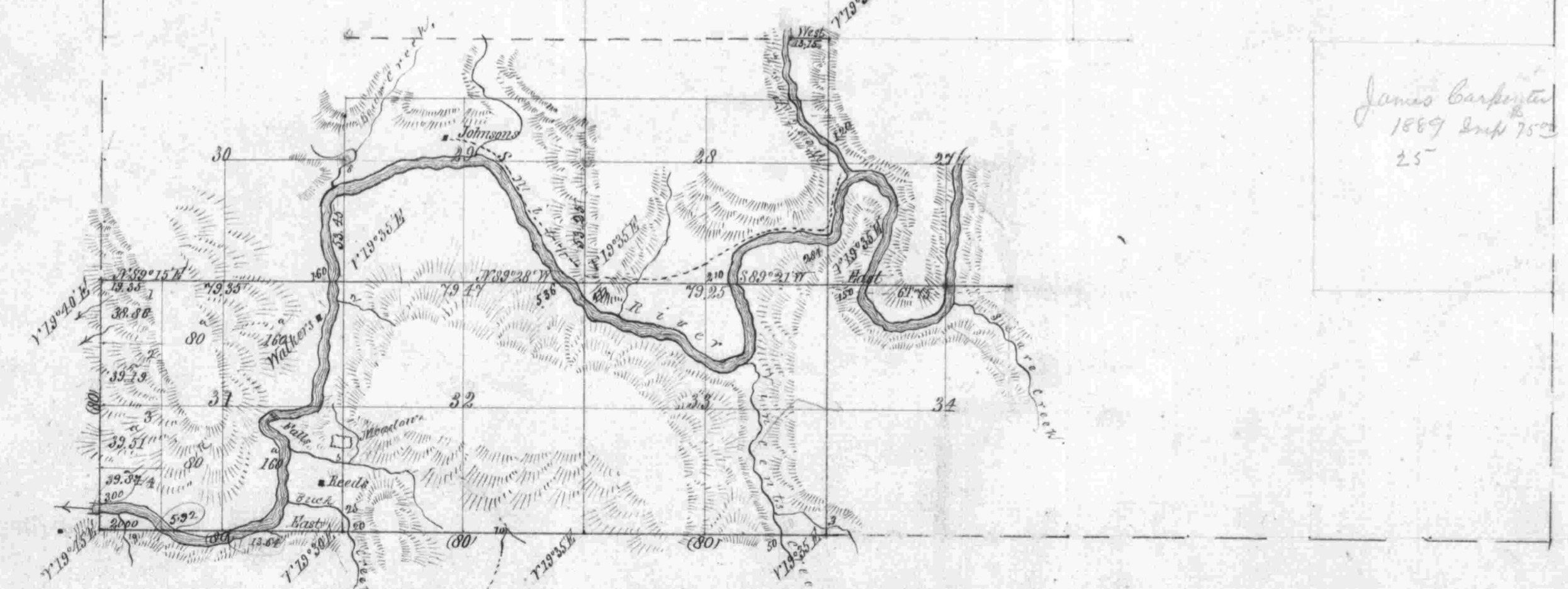

General Description
