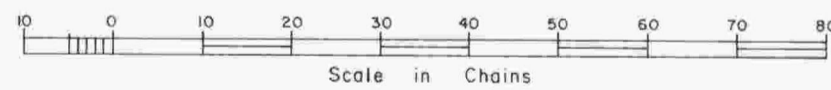
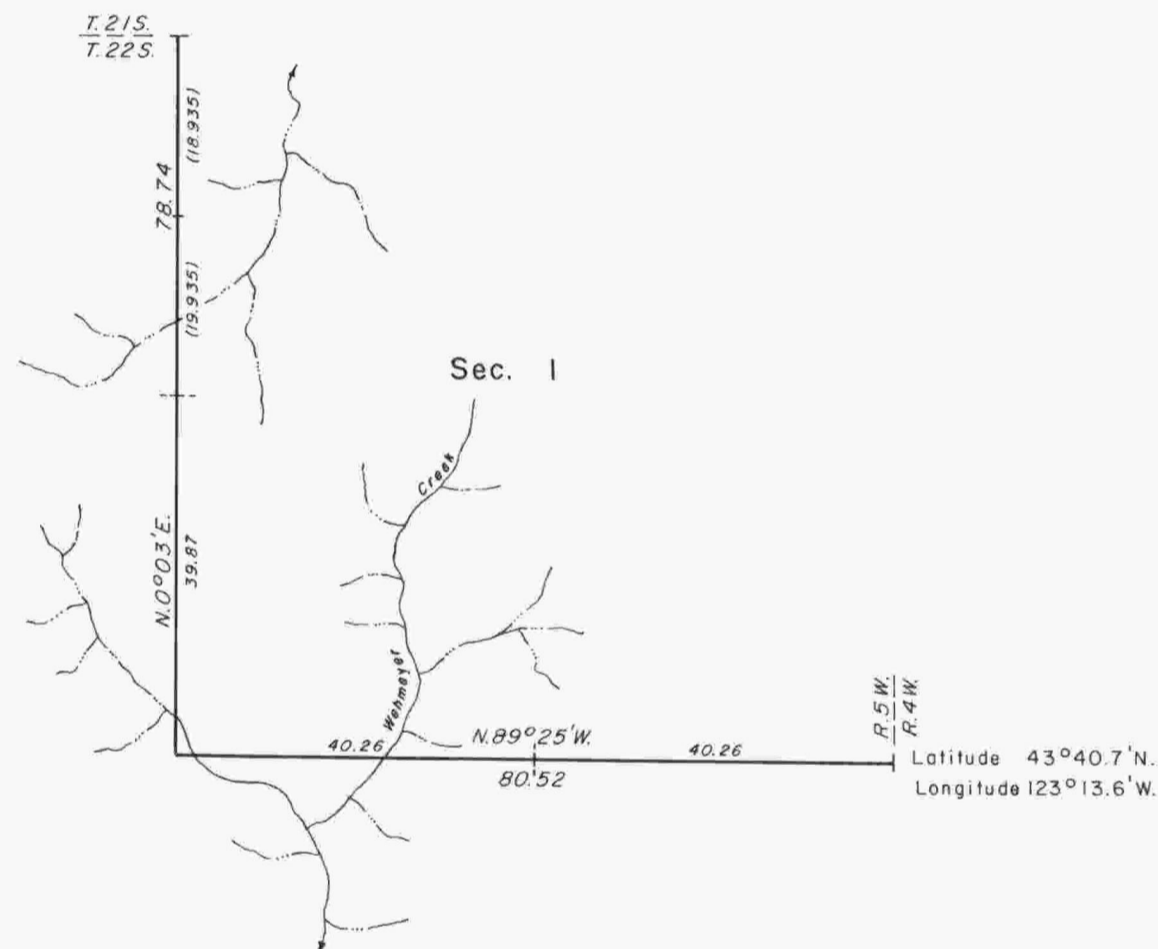

A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents a dependent resurvey of a portion of the subdivisional lines of T. 22 S., R. 5 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence.

The survey was executed by James E. Jelley and Wayne L. Rogers, Cadastral Surveyors, beginning June 17, 1982, and completed July 8, 1982, pursuant to Special Instructions dated May 13, 1982, for Group No. 1103, Oregon.

Timber in this area consists of fir, yew, hemlock, cedar, chinquapin, oak, madrone, cascara, ash, and alder.
