A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents a dependent resurvey of a portion of the east and north boundaries, T. 22 S., R. 12 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence.

The lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved September 6, 1858.

The survey was executed by Deborah M. Stephens and Harvey E. Wofford, Cadastral Surveyors, beginning April 9, 1990, and completed April 3, 1995, pursuant to Special Instructions dated January 8, 1990, and Supplemental Special Instructions dated April 11, 1991, under Group Number 1521, Oregon.

Timber in this area consists of alder, cedar, fir, hemlock, maple, myrtle, madrone, and spruce.

The tie to the geodetic control station is reported as mean bearing and sea level distance.
