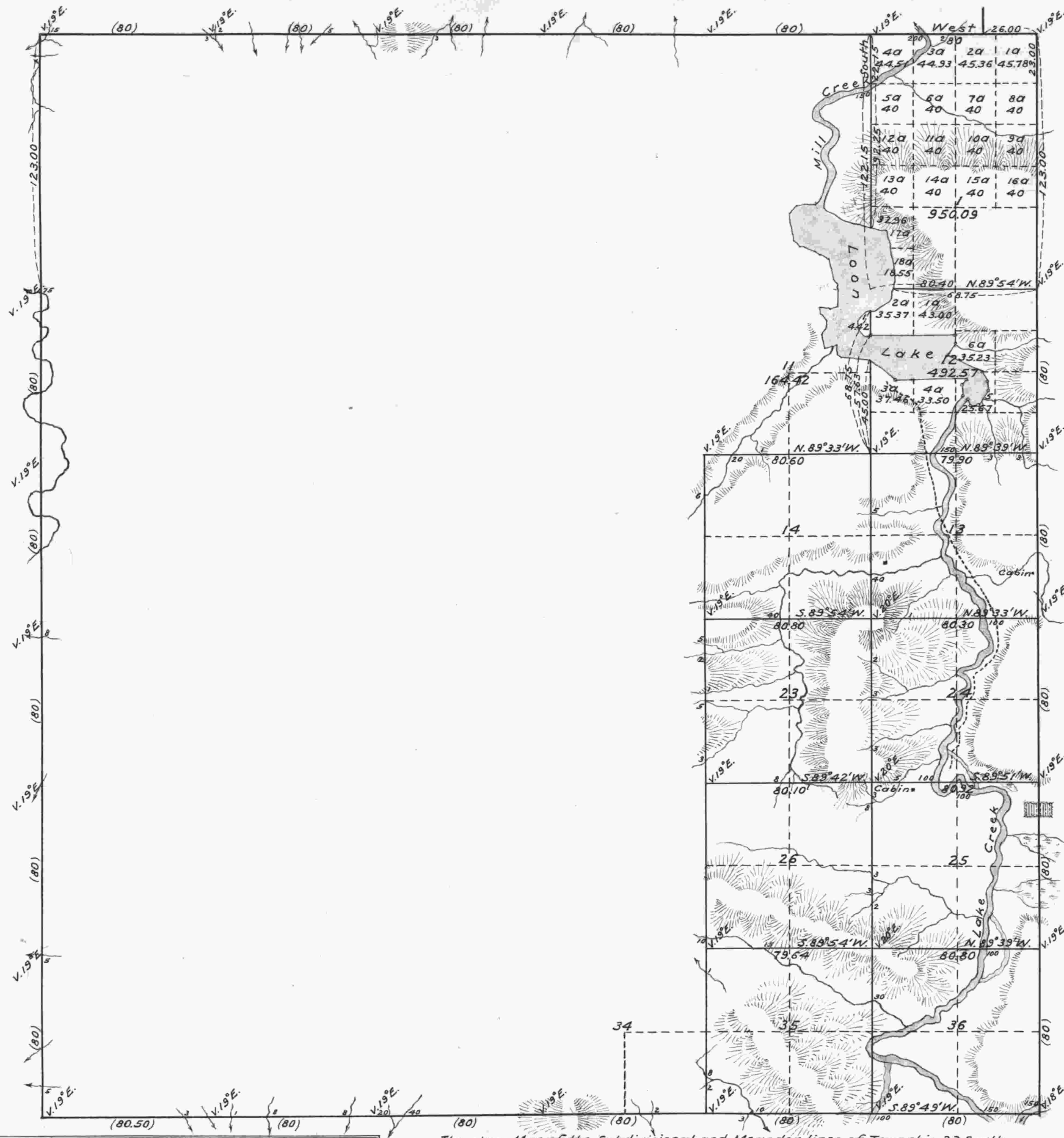


Township No. 23 South, Range No. 10 West, Willamette Meridian, Oregon.



General Description.
 The quality of the lands in this Township is varied. The land along Lake Creek is rich bottom varying in width from 5 to 60 chains. Some bench lands are found on the hills back from the Creek, which are good and susceptible of cultivation. A vast amount however is broken mountainous and 3^d rate. Timber burned off. The valley, above the lake, overflows during extreme high water. The bottoms are covered with the finest quality of Myrtle and Maple timber.
