

TOWNSHIP 24 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, OF THE WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN, OREGON.  
DEPENDENT RESURVEY

This plat represents a retracement and reestablishment of a portion of the east boundary, T. 24 S., R. 2 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence.

The east boundary of the township was surveyed by John A. McQuinn in 1883.

In 1896, Winfield S. Chapman and Carl S. Nicklin retraced the east boundary of the township and surveyed the subdivisional lines of T. 24 S., R. 1 W., closing against the McQuinn line.

Levi E. Tallett dependently resurveyed the east boundary of section 36 in 1951.

The resurvey was executed by Lynn M. Roseberry, Cadastral Surveyor, May 16 to 24, 1967, under Special Instructions dated April 12, 1967, which provide for the surveys included under Group No. 634, Oregon.

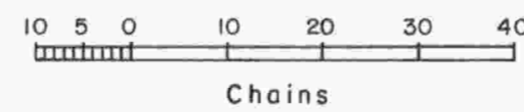
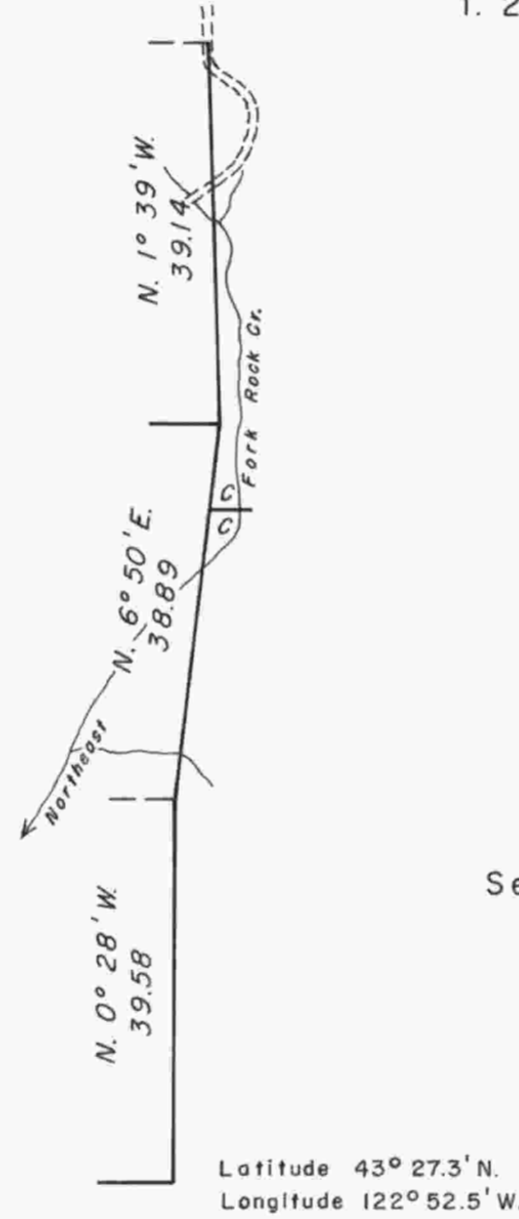
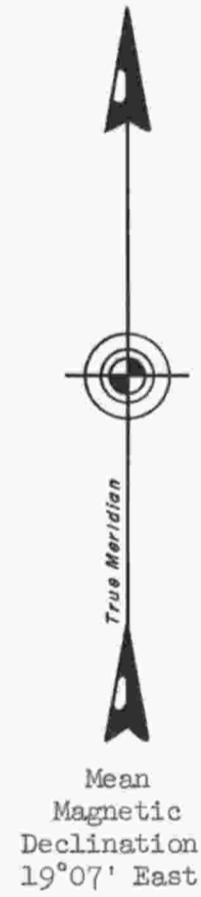
