This plat represents a retracement and reestablishment of a portion of the east boundary of T. 24 S., R. 7 W., and a portion of the south boundary of T. 23 S., R. 7 W., designed to restore the corners in their true original location according to the best available evidence.

The east boundary of T. 24 S., R. 7 W. was surveyed by Henry S. Gile in 1853.

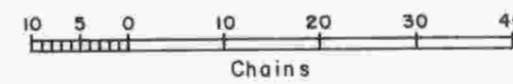
The south boundary of T. 23 S., R. 7 W. was surveyed by W. H. Byars in 1881.

Dependent resurvey of a portion of the east boundary of T. 24 S., R. 7 W. and a portion of the south boundary of T. 23 S., R. 7 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon, executed by Orville N. Eggen, May 31 to August 9, 1957, under Special Instructions dated April 8, 1940 which provide for the surveys included under Group No. 244, Oregon.
