

TOWNSHIP 24 SOUTH, RANGE 7 WEST, OF THE WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN, OREGON  
 CORRECTIVE DEPENDENT RESURVEY



A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.  
 This plat represents a corrective dependent resurvey of a portion of the east and north boundaries, T. 24 S., R. 7 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence.  
 The lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved April 24, 1858.  
 The survey was executed by Dale T. Bedell, Cadastral Surveyor, beginning May 4, 1992, and completed April 19, 1993, pursuant to Special Instructions dated February 21, 1992, under Group Number 1637, Oregon.  
 Timber in this area consists of fir, cedar, hemlock, pine, yew, alder, cherry, maple, oak, madrone, willow, ash, and chinquapin.
