DEPENDENT RESURVEY

This plat represents a retracement and reestablishment of the line between sections 20 and 29, T. 25 S., R. 1 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence.

The subdivisional lines were surveyed by Hezekiah H. Johnson in 1900.

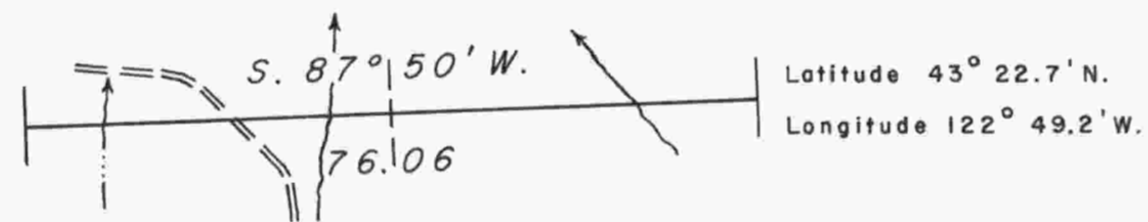

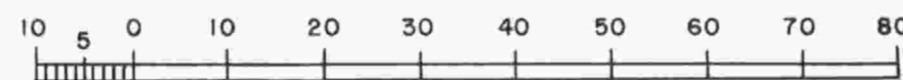
