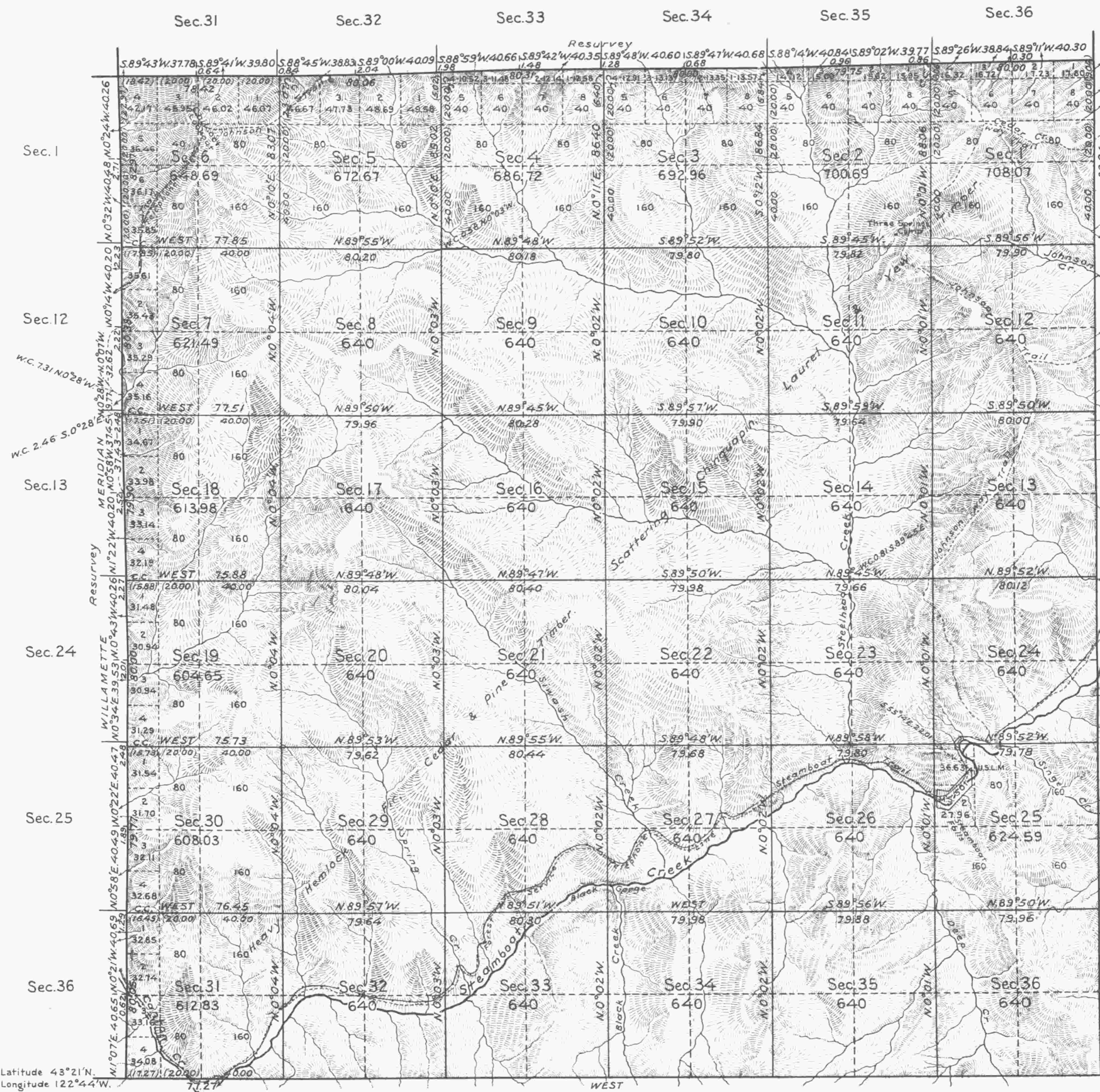


TOWNSHIP NO 25 SOUTH, RANGE NO 1 EAST OF THE WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN, OREGON.
