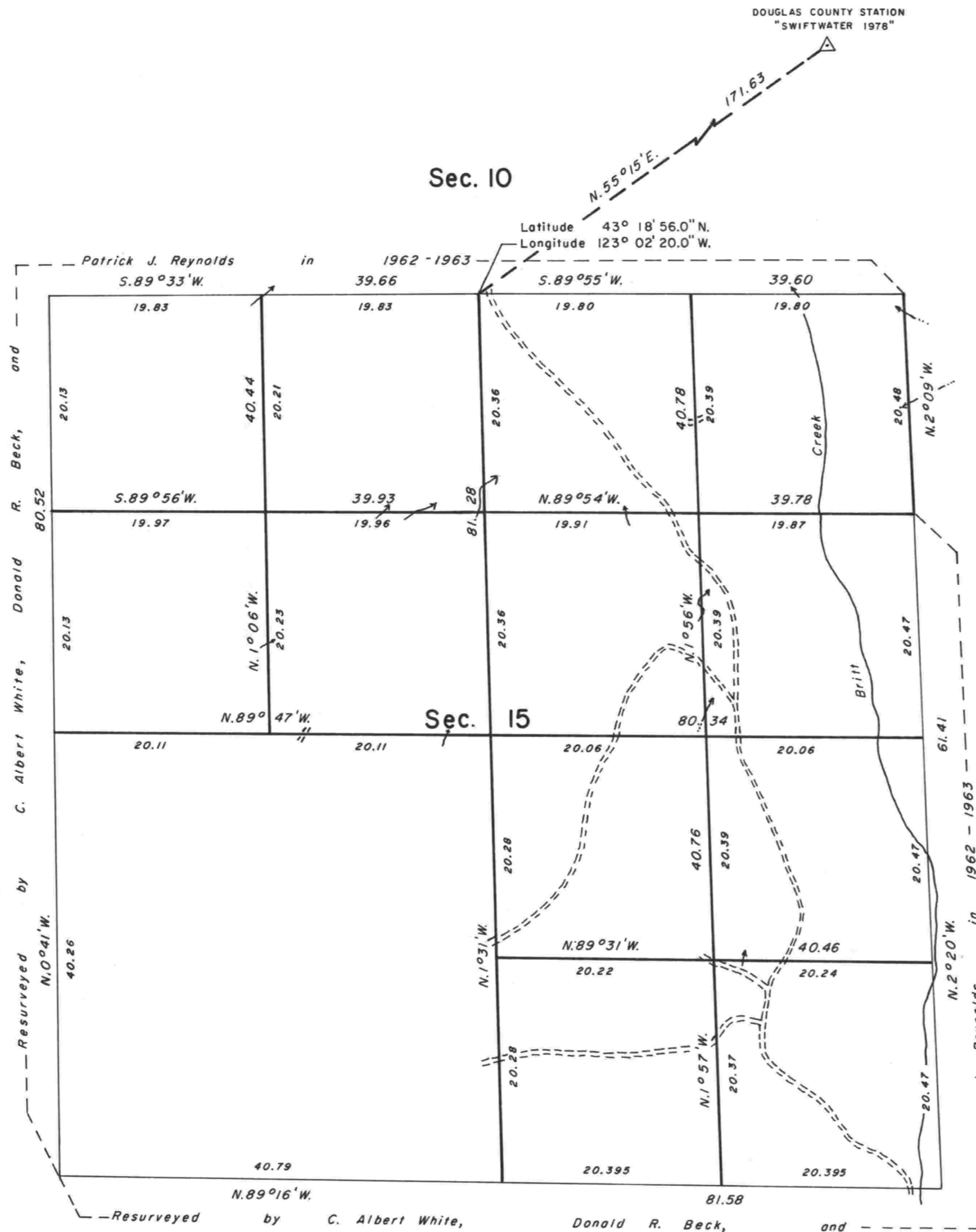

The history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents a dependent resurvey of a portion of the subdivisional lines, T. 26 S., R. 3 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon, and the subdivision of section 15.

The lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved October 23, 1882.

The survey was executed by Lance J. Bishop and Wayne L. Rogers, Cadastral Surveyors, beginning July 26, 1984, and completed September 4, 1984, pursuant to Special Instructions dated April 30, 1984, under Group Number 1207, Oregon.

Timber in this area consists of hemlock, cedar, fir, pine, oak, madrone, maple, and yew.
