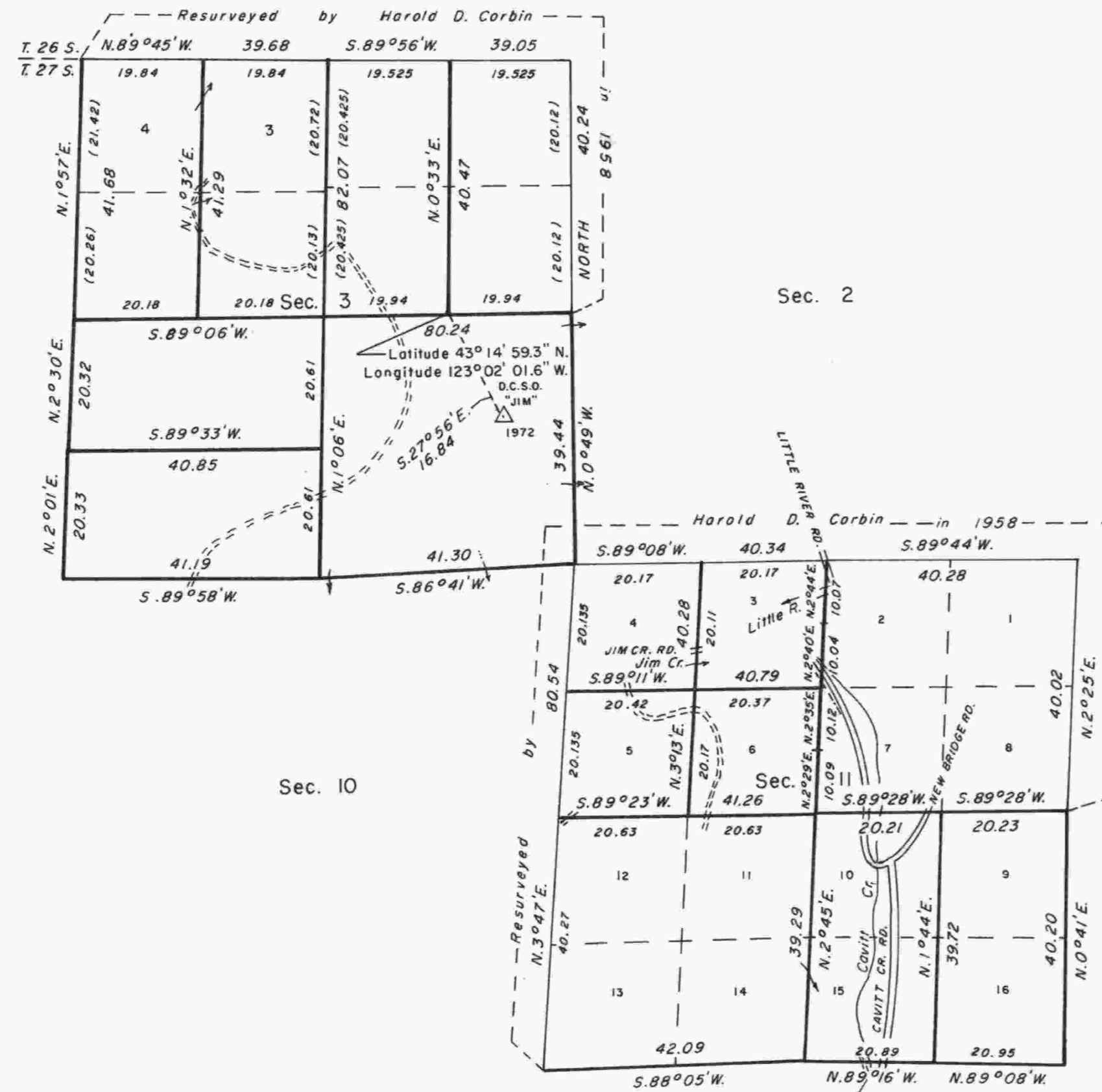

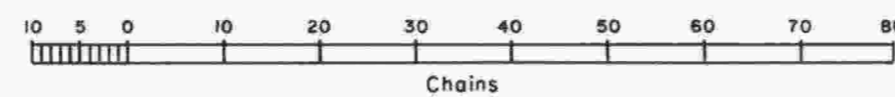

The history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents a dependent resurvey of a portion of the subdivisional lines, T. 27 S., R. 3 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, and the subdivision of sections 3 and 11.

The lottings and areas are as shown on the plats approved March 26, 1872, and October 23, 1882.

The survey was executed by Lance J. Bishop and Wayne L. Rogers, Cadastral Surveyors, beginning May 9, 1984, and completed July 24, 1984, pursuant to Special Instructions dated December 12, 1983, under Group Number 1189, Oregon.

Timber in this area consists of hemlock, cedar, fir, yew, madrone, oak, maple, and chinquapin.
