A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents a dependent resurvey of a portion of the subdivision lines and subdivision of section lines in sections 9 and 21, T. 29 S., R. 3 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence.

The survey was performed utilizing both conventional (directly measured angles and distances) and NAVSTAR Global Positioning System (GPS) satellite techniques. The GPS measurements utilized dual frequency, carrier phase GPS receivers. The baselines were computed in and adjusted by least squares analysis using Trimble Geomatics Office (TGO). Conventionally measured distances and directions have been adjusted by Cadastral Measurement Management for Windows (WinCMM), computer software that incorporates a least squares adjustment routine. The adjusted bearings and distances are reported to the nearest second and 0.01 foot.

Where not indicated, the lottings and areas are as shown on the plats approved February 20, 1858 and August 11, 1881.

The survey was executed by A. Bert Skeesick, Cadastral Surveyor, and Robert H. Browning, Surveying Technician, beginning April 2, 2007, and completed May 24, 2007, pursuant to Special Instructions dated January 9, 2007, approved January 12, 2007, under Group Number 2154, Oregon.
