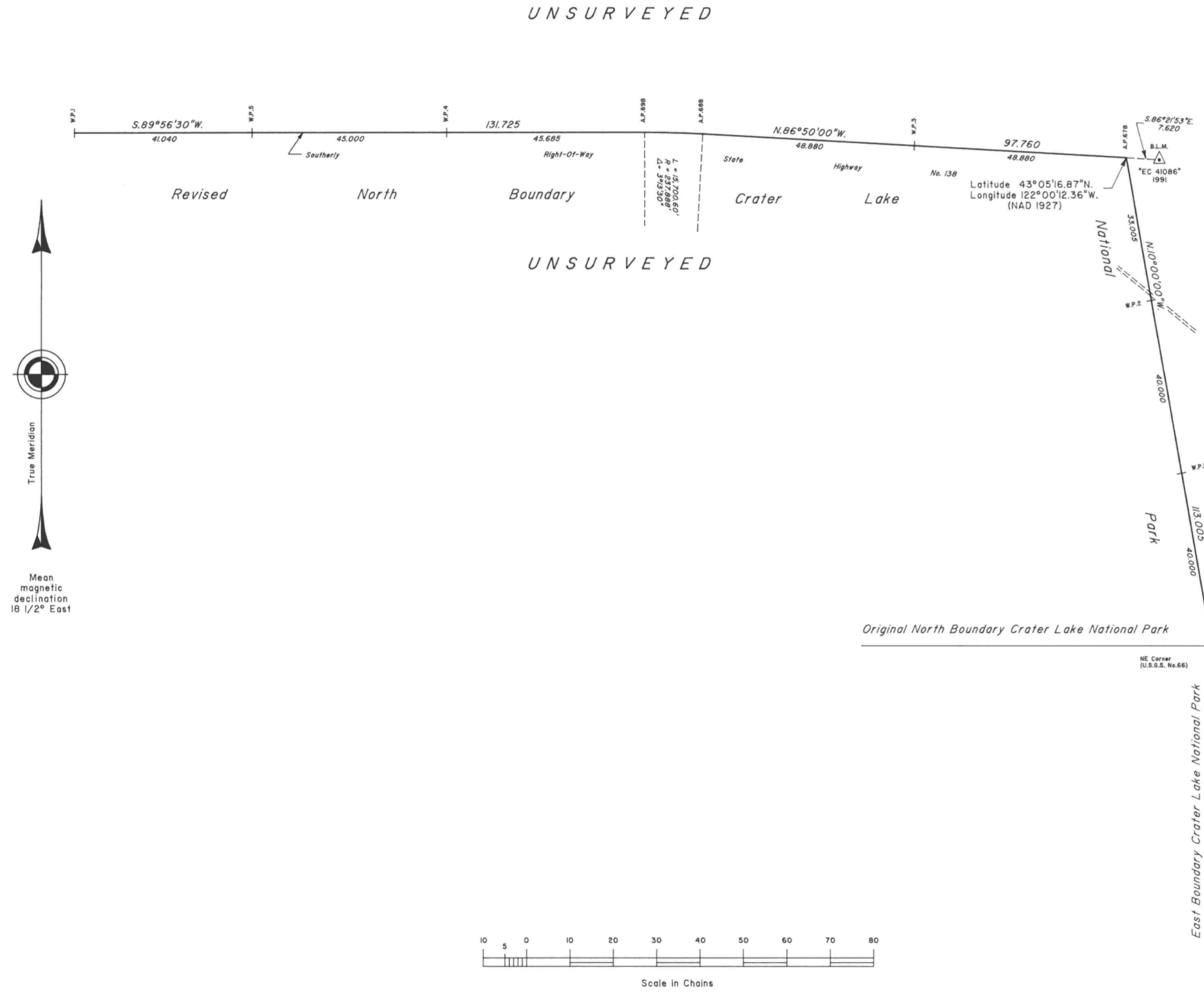


TOWNSHIP 29 SOUTH, RANGE 6 EAST, OF THE WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN, OREGON SURVEY



A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents a metes-and-bounds survey of the Revised North Boundary of the Crater Lake National Park, T. 29 S., R. 6 E., Willamette Meridian, Oregon.

The survey was executed by Daniel E. Weller, Cadastral Surveyor, beginning October 1, 1991, and completed July 22, 1992, pursuant to Special Instructions dated September 11, 1990, under Group Number 1571, Oregon.

Timber in this area is primarily pine.

The tie to the geodetic control station is reported as mean bearing and sea level distance.
