

# TOWNSHIP 29 SOUTH, RANGE 7 WEST, OF THE WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN, OREGON.

DEPENDENT RESURVEY



This plat represents a retracement and reestablishment of portions of the east boundary and subdivisional lines designed to restore the corners in their true original location according to the best available evidence. Lottings and areas are as shown on plat approved March 9, 1855 except as new lottings are shown hereon.

A portion of Township 29 South, Range 7 West was surveyed by Nathaniel Ford in 1854.

The south boundary of Sections 13 and 14 was resurveyed by Roy T. Campbell in 1910 and retraced by Fred Mensch in 1924.

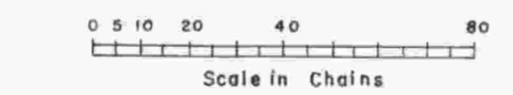
A dependent resurvey and partial subdivision of Section 9 was made in 1955 by Hans W. Thielsen.

Dependent resurvey of portions of the east boundary and subdivisional lines of T. 29 S., R. 7 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon, executed by Hans W. Thielsen April 18, 1957 to May 10, 1957, under Special Instructions dated March 29, 1957, which provide for the surveys included under Group 346, Oregon.

West 1/2 South Boundary Section 13, 44.37 instead of 44.57 W.W.G.

Timber in this area consists of Douglas fir, cedar, oak, pine, madrona, chinquapin, maple, and alder.

Certain resurveys in connection with sections 15, 16, 21, and 22, T. 29 S., R. 7 W. have been cancelled by authority of Directors memorandum 9182(420) dated August 31, 1970. The portions affected have been deleted. See Plat Accepted June 5, 1970.
