

TOWNSHIP 29 SOUTH, RANGE 7 WEST, OF THE WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN, OREGON.
DEPENDENT RESURVEY

This plat represents a retracement and reestablishment of a portion of the south boundary and a portion of the subdivisional lines, T. 29 S., R. 7 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon, designed to restore the corners in their true original location according to the best available evidence.

The lottings and areas are as shown on the plats approved March 9, 1855, July 30, 1898, and February 15, 1926, Tps. 29 and 29½ S., R. 7 W.

The south boundary and a portion of the subdivisional lines were surveyed by Nathaniel Ford, in 1854.

The Bell Placer Mine and William Reynolds Mineral Claim, located in section 27, were segregated by Eugene Schiller, in 1898. During the course of the segregation survey, Schiller retraced the south one-half mile between sections 27 and 28.

The west four miles of the south boundary and portions of the subdivisional lines were resurveyed and surveyed by Fred Mensch, in 1924.

A portion of the subdivisional lines was resurveyed by Hans W. Thielsen, in 1957. Portions of this resurvey were cancelled by authority of Directors Memorandum 9182(420) dated August 31, 1970.

The boundaries of section 21 were resurveyed and section 21 was subdivided by John M. Jelley, in 1966.

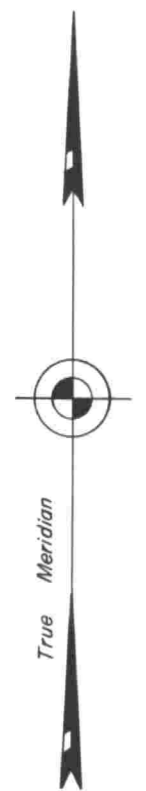
The resurvey was executed by Harvey E. Wofford, G. Steven Popken, and James J. Carlson, Cadastral Surveyors, from September 26, 1974 to May 6, 1976, under Special Instructions dated August 29, 1974, which provide for the surveys included under Group No. 851, Oregon.

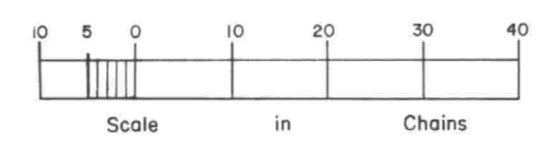
