The original field notes of the survey of the Mining Claim of Edson Adams and Harvey S. Brown, trustee for Harvey Brown, known as the Emerald Lode Claim, from which this plat has been made under my direction, have been examined and approved, and are on file in this office, and I hereby certify that they furnish such an accurate description of said Mining Claim as will, if incorporated into a patent, serve fully to identify the premises, and that such reference is made therein to natural objects or permanent monuments as will perpetuate and fix the locus thereof. I further certify that Five Hundred Dollars worth of labor has been expended or improvements made upon said Mining Claim by claimant or their grantors, and that said improvements consist of Cuts and shaft to wit: No 1 11 feet long, average depth 1 1/2 feet, average width 8 feet, shaft No 1 33 feet deep, shaft 1 x 1 feet in the clear, well timbered. Cut No 2 31 feet long, average depth 1 1/2 feet, average width 10 feet. Cut No 3 31 feet long, average depth 3 feet, width 4 feet. that the location of said improvements is correctly shown upon this plat and that no portion of said labor or improvements has been included in the estimate of expenditures upon any other claim. And I further certify that this is a correct plat of said Mining Claim, made in conformity with said original field notes of the survey thereof, and the same is hereby approved.
