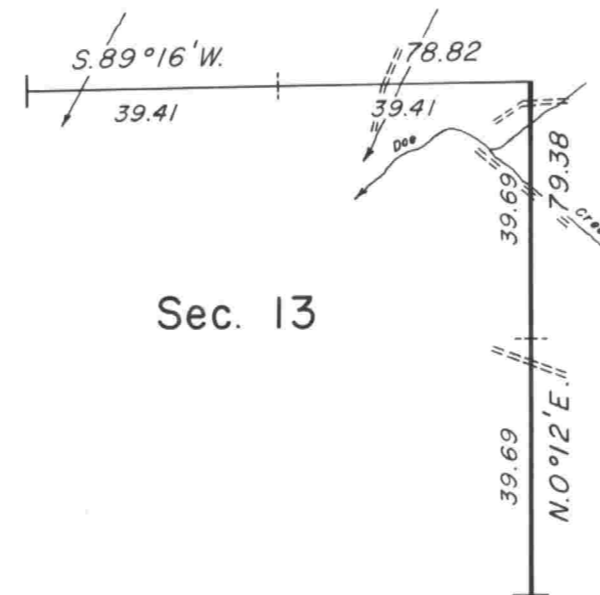


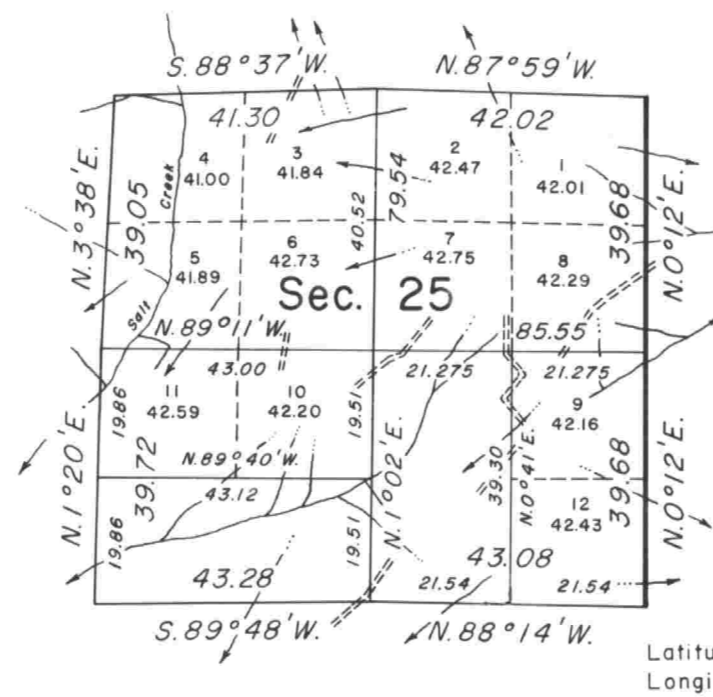
TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 7 WEST, OF THE WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN, OREGON.

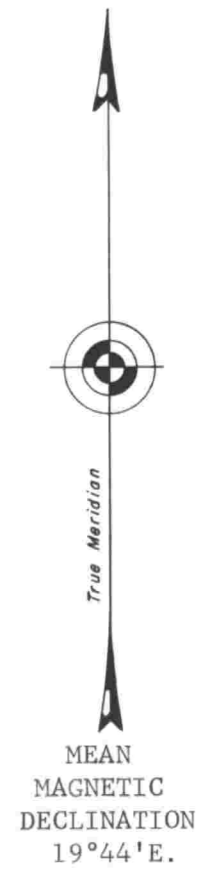
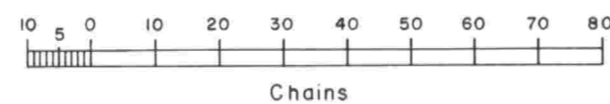

This plat represents a retracement and reestablishment of a portion of the east boundary and subdivisional lines, T. 30 S., R. 7 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon, designed to restore the corners in their true original location according to the best available evidence, and subdivision of section 25.

Excepting as new or modified vacant subdivisions as shown hereon, the lottings and areas are as shown on the plats approved October 1, 1872, July 28, 1883, and January 20, 1919.

The east boundary was surveyed by Addison R. Flint, in 1855.

The subdivisional lines were surveyed by William H. Byars, in 1872.

This survey was executed by James E. Jelley and Charles E. Akin, Jr., Cadastral Surveyors, from April 16, 1971 to October 12, 1973, under Special Instructions dated March 8, 1971, and October 3, 1973, which provide for the surveys included under Group Nos. 734 and 829.
