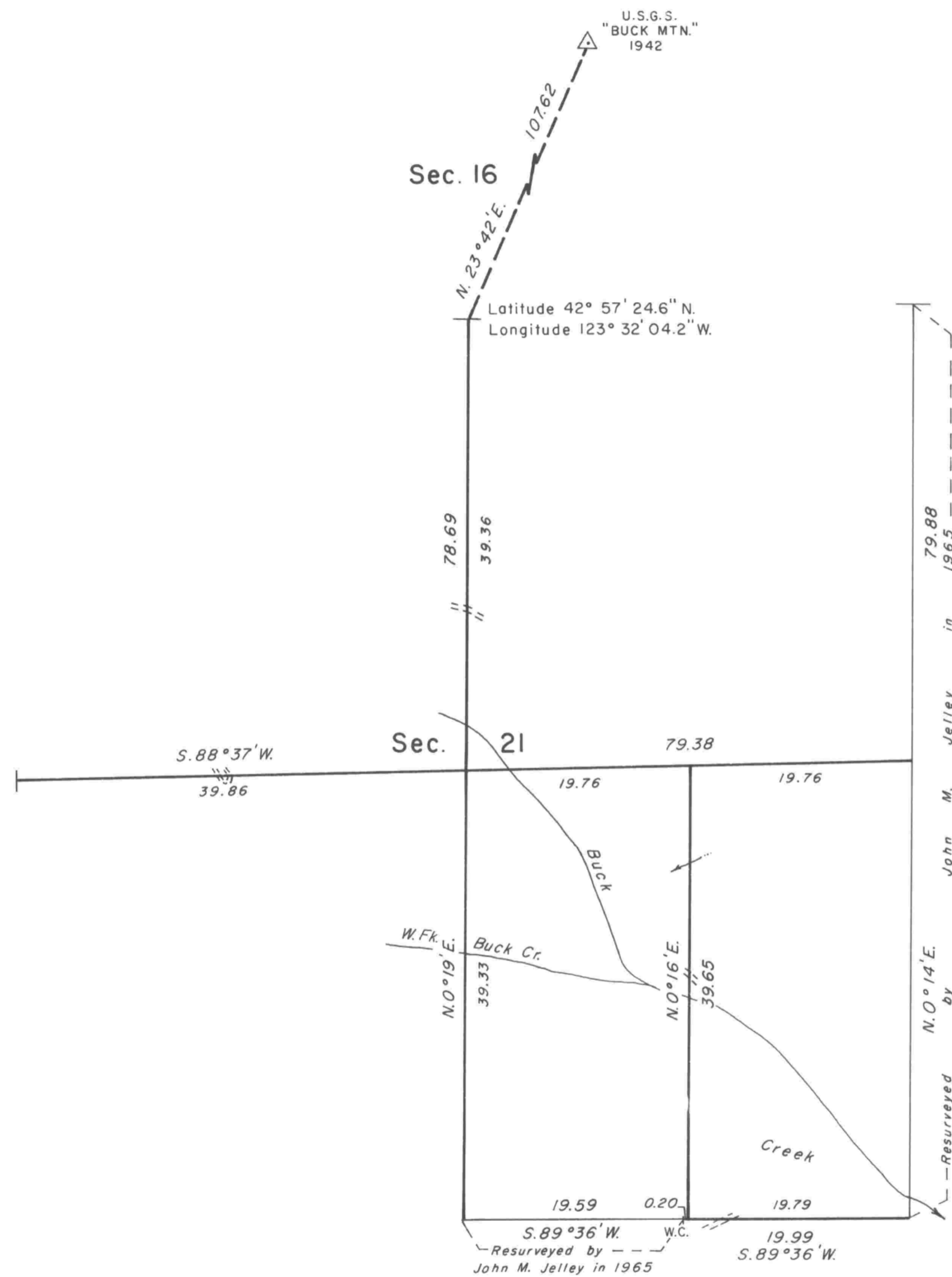

A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents a dependent resurvey of a portion of the subdivisional lines, T. 30 S., R. 7 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, and the subdivision of section 21.

The lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved July 28, 1883.

The survey was executed by Lance J. Bishop, Cadastral Surveyor, beginning September 20, 1983, and completed September 29, 1983, pursuant to Special Instructions dated July 27, 1983, under Group Number 1170, Oregon.

Timber in this area consists of fir, hemlock, cedar, pine, oak, maple, alder, and yew.
