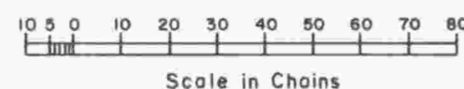
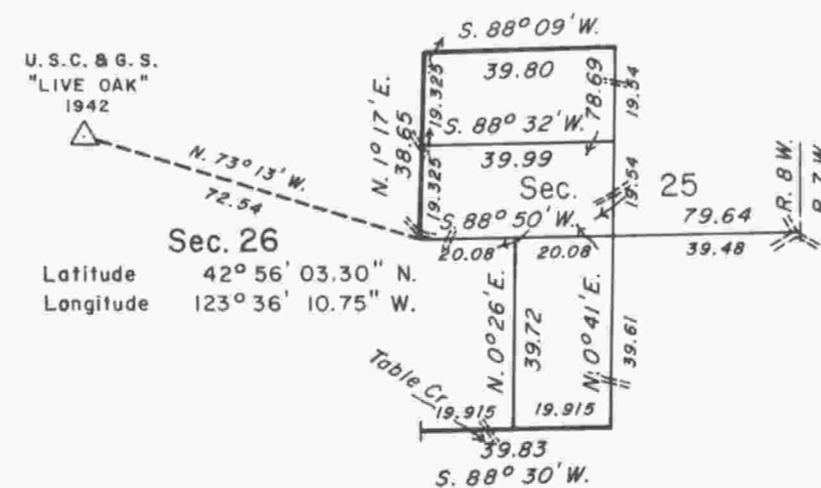

The history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents a dependent resurvey of a portion of the subdivisional lines, T. 30 S., R. 8 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, and the subdivision of section 25.

The lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved July 28, 1883.

The survey was executed by Wayne L. Rogers, Lance J. Bishop, and James L. White, Cadastral Surveyors, beginning February 14, 1985, and completed July 2, 1985, pursuant to Special Instructions dated October 18, 1984, under Group Number 1240, Oregon.

Timber in this area consists of fir, cedar, pine, hemlock, yew, alder, oak, madrone, chinquapin, willow, maple, cherry, and dogwood.
