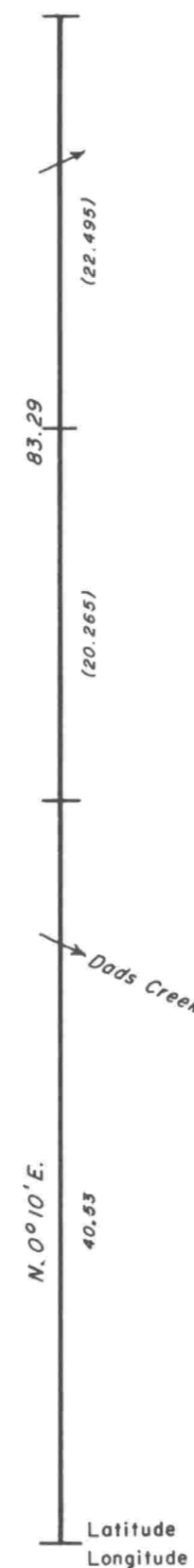

A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents a dependent resurvey of a portion of the subdivisional lines, T. 31 S., R. 7 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence.

The survey was executed by James L. White, Cadastral Surveyor, beginning January 23, 1985, and completed February 1, 1985, pursuant to Special Instructions dated October 12, 1984, under Group Number 1239, Oregon.

Timber in this area consists of fir, hemlock, yew, cedar, alder, madrone, oak, chinquapin, willow, maple, and ash.
