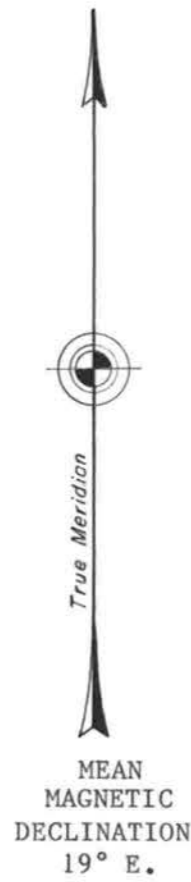
The lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved March 31, 1856.

Section 27 was dependently resurveyed and subdivided by Joseph S. Gawron and Hans W. Thielsen, in 1958-1963.

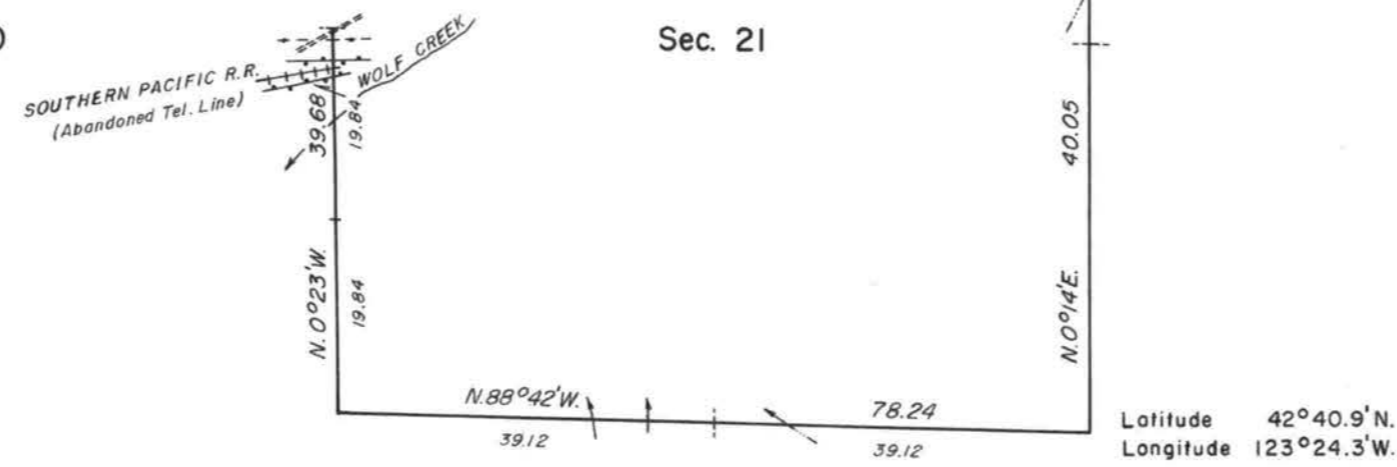

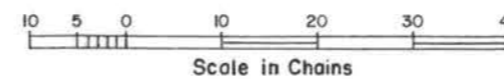
