✓ Cen. Sec 9 - Set 4x4 Ced Post for Cor. Fr. wh.

6" " " S83 1/2°E. 23 ft.

✓ 1/4 Sec Cor Bet. 23/26 ← SHOULD BE T23/R5 22-9-23-59  
Location identified from an original bearing tree, a 30" Elder N 31°E 22 lks. This tree was dead & quite rotten but still standing on the bank of Pollock Creek. When chopped out, scribe marks were visible in the fungus film between the surface of the original blaze. Drove a 1" iron pipe 48" long, 46" in ground for the corner & set a cedar post 4" sq. 60 ins. long along side, scribed 1/4 S 23 - 1/4 S 26 C.S. from which a fir 14 ins. diam. bears N 21°W. 46.8 ft blazed & scribed 1/4 S 23 C.S. B.T. & Fir 20" diam., bears S 22 1/2°E 64.1 ft. blazed & scribed 1/4 S 26 C.S. B.T.

✓ 1/4 Cor. bet. Secs. 20 & 21. Set 4" x 4" x 36" sq Fir Post for corner from B.Ts, namely; Fir S. 25°E 25 lks, in good condition & O.K. rescribed on bark 1/4 S 21 T 23 S R 4 W. & also from other original B.T. Fir S 15°W 7 lks. which is down but the stump hole is still O.K. (Found scribe marks on it) Marked New Tree, 36" Fir S 62°W 60 feet (on slope) Marked 1/4 S 20. T, 23 S, R 4 W. C.S. B.T.

✓ Corner to Secs. 20-21-28 & 29.  
Set 4" x 4" x 40" Cedar Post marked S 26 - S 21 - S 28 + 29 T 23 S R 4 W from one old B.T. only, a W Oak N 18 3/4°W 878 lks. which is sound & standing. Marked New B.Ts, as follows:  
36" Wye Cedar N 1 A°E 85.3 ft. (on slope) Marked S 21 T 23 S R 4 W. C.S. B.T.  
20" Forked Ash S 54°E 290.3 ft. (on slope) Marked S 28 T 23 S R 4 W C.S. B.T.  
12" Cedar S 8 1/2°W 205.2 ft (on slope) Marked S 29, T 23 S, R. 4 W C.S. B.T.

✓ Corner to Secs. 1, 2, 11 & 12  
I established this corner from the S.E. & S.W. bearing trees both dead, cut in S.W. tree & found old marks. N.E. & N.W. trees gone. Set a stone 24" x 16" x 12" in mound of stones, 12 inches in ground marked x & c.s. from which I marked:  
A Fir 10" in diam. bears N 63°E 30.7 feet, Marked T 23 S. R. 4 W. Section I, C.S.  
A Fir 30" in diam., bears N 80°W 9.6 ft. Marked T. 23. S, R. 4 W. Sec. 2. C.S.  
A Fir 20" in. diam., bears S. 51°W. 42. ft. " T 23. S R 4 W " 11. C.S.  
A Fir 28" in. diam., bears S 66°E. 15.8 Ft. " T. 23 S. R. 4 W sec. 12. C.S.

✓ 1/4 Cor bet Sec. 6 & 7  
Location identified from old B.Ts. S E 10 lks good condition & scribed. Marks plain. Stump of O.B.T. N 59°E. 50 lks scribe marks visible. Corner Rock set by Thiel 1899 gone & Fence Post set in place. Set a stone 2 1/2" x 12" x 24" long, 12" in ground for corner in a mound of rock 30" diam, & 18" high from which a tree bears N 63°E 40 lks Marked 1/4 S 6 C.S. B.T.

✓ 1/4 Cor. bet. 29 & 30. Found that someone found the decayed cherry B.T. & scribed two new Bearing Trees for the renewed cor - the cherry tree was just a rotten stump - this renewed corner prob set by Oscar Thiel - The New B.Ts are 30" Fir N. 10°W. 10 ft scribed on bark 1/4 C.S. B.T. & 15" Cedar S 55°E 17.0 ft. scribed & c.s. B.T. a 3" x 3" Fir Post is at corner - Probably renewed or relocated in 1942
