Renewed this corner from the remains of the original B.T. as follows.

I set a Cedar B.T. which is standing, live and bearing scribe marks, thence $N 85^{\circ} E 101 \frac{1}{2}$ ft. and from this point

A burned out stump $N 50^{\circ} W 97 \frac{1}{2}$ ft.

A stump 24 dia $N 33^{\circ} E 112 \frac{1}{2}$ ft.

A hole where tree had burned out $S 48^{\circ} E 80$ ft.

I set a sand stone $10 \times 10 \times 15$ marker C. S. on North and X on top, 2 notches on East and one on South and made mound of rock. notes suitable for bearing trees

$\frac{1}{4}$ Corner 29-32. Old B.T. gone so set $\frac{1}{2} \times 20$ I.P. by perpendicular distance between section corner of section which were found marked New B.T. $\frac{1}{2}$ Fir $18^{\circ} S 80^{\circ} W 162$ feet

Corner 29-30-31-32 set corner from old B.T. in sec 29 found evidence of old B.T. trees in 31 & 32 but saw scum make except on B.T. in sec 29. set a $2 \times 2 \times 20$ square iron pipe, marked New B.T. as follows

Corner sections 28-29-32-33 Found old B.T. in sec 28 and set corner from it. Then checked out and found B.T. in sec 29-33. in evidence set a $2 \times 2 \times 20$ square iron pipe for corner also $204 \times 4 \times 4$ Oak stake Marked New B.T. $15^{\circ} W.O. N 81^{\circ} W 35$ like $15^{\circ} W.O. N 62^{\circ} E 83 \frac{1}{2}$
 $15^{\circ} W.O. S 67^{\circ} 30^{\circ} E 98 \frac{1}{2}$ on tree near in sec 32
