Found stump that had evidence of blaze. Albert Robinson said years ago

14" Fir N 26° E 4 1/2 ft; 10" Fir S 30° W 33° ft

✓ Cor corner to 27-28-33-34.

#8 set 3/4" Iron pipe from orig. B.Ts, standing, set squared wood marker by pipe.

✓ 1/4 Cor bet 28 & 33.

#9 Found a 44" Fir that had blaze mark in bark but had burned badly. 70 ft South was stump hole of small tree; I measured to top of hill from this tree and it was 450± ft. So I assumed the tree to be Orig B.T.

Set a 1" I. Pipe for corner.

44" Fir N 30° E 142° ft. 24" white Fir S 28 1/2° W 73° ft.

✓ 1/4 bet 27 & 34.

#11 set Iron pipe from 30" Orig B.T. Charred stump of other B.T. present.
Marked a 30" Fir N 80° E 23° ft; 30" Fir S 22° E 59 1/2° ft.

✓ 1/4 Cor. between 34 and 35

set Iron Pipe for corner. Found 2 original B.T., both badly rotted

#12 Marked 24" Fir N 26 1/2° E 49° ft; 18" Fir S 64° W 33 1/2° ft.
