2" x 30"

Renewed this corner from the two original
Beaving trees which are alive and standing
and which I identified by the scars, but I
did not chop open. I set an oak post
4" x 4" x 40" for corner and erected a mound
of rock around the post.

Renewed this corner from the original
B's which were alive and standing scribe
marks were visible on one which I chopped
open the other tree was identified by its beaving
and scars. Set an iron plow share and
a 4x4x40 Oak post for corner.
